JAN P. MALKIEWICZ YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

1. GENERAL

Knights of Columbus Sons of Mother Seton Council 9847 has established the Jan P. Malkiewicz Foundation to encourage youth of our parish to pursue post-secondary education. The scholarship(s) will be awarded based upon availability of funds. This scholarship is separate from the scholarship offered by the parish and eligible students may apply for both scholarships. The Foundation Advisory Committee will give preference to the children of registered members of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton parish and are graduating high school seniors preparing to attend an accredited college or institution.

2. APPLICATION

Application for these scholarships shall be made only through the completion of this application document with all of its attached forms postmarked by June 1st and must be received by the Knights of Columbus Council 9847 Jan P. Malkiewicz Advisory Committee. All eligible applications will be carefully and prudently evaluated by the Council's Advisory Committee strictly on the basis of the information submitted by means of this application document. Please note that all information received will be held in strict confidence by the Advisory Committee of Sons of Mother Seton Council 9847 and will be considered property as such. Any incomplete applications will be disqualified. Not all applicants may receive a scholarship.

3. BASIS FOR AWARD

The Council's Advisory Committee will make a decision primarily from the application criteria provided below; however, it is not exclusive. The Council's Advisory Committee shall evaluate each application to determine the extent to which an individual demonstrates service to the Church, academic excellence, and community service.

4. APPLICATION CRITERIA

The following criteria will determine eligibility for scholarship(s) awarded:

- a. Applicant's family are registered members of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish
- b. Applicant is a high school graduating student preparing to enter college or an accredited institution
- c. Applicant is a practicing Catholic
- d. Applicant demonstrates academic excellence
- e. Applicant demonstrates service to the Church and community
- f. Applicant demonstrates leadership and character

The Foundation Advisory Committee may amend this application at any time as it deems necessary.
